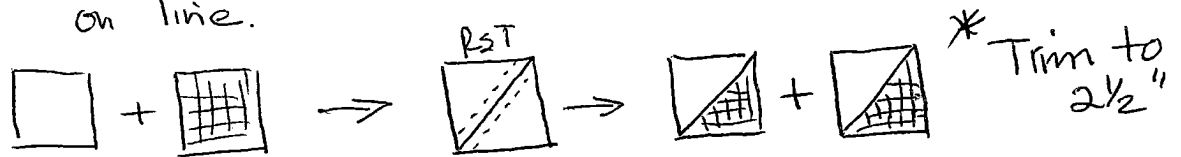
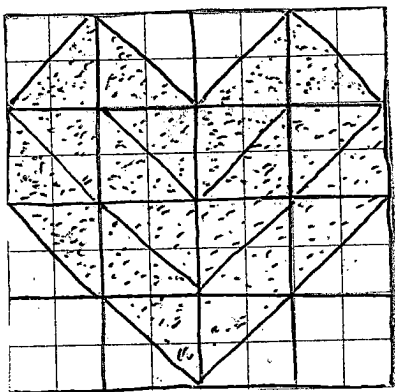


8" Scrappy Heart - 3 ways

- These blocks are made of HST's, arranged in different ways.
- HST 2 methods
 - a. Cut 3" squares, cut diagonally into 2 triangles
Join triangles along long bias edge, being careful not to stretch. Iron with Best Press - helps stabilize
Cutting triangles gives more variety in the block with no repeated fabrics unless desired. Very scrap friendly! Iron open or to darker side.
 - b. Place 2 desired 3" squares right sides together
Draw a line corner to corner diagonally. Stitch a scant $\frac{1}{4}$ " on either side of line. Cut apart on line.



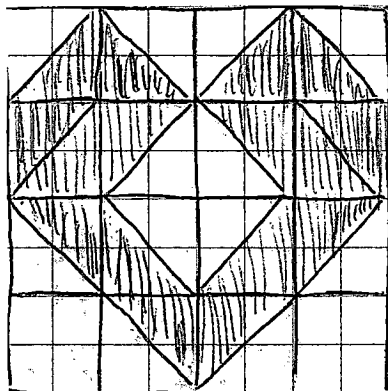

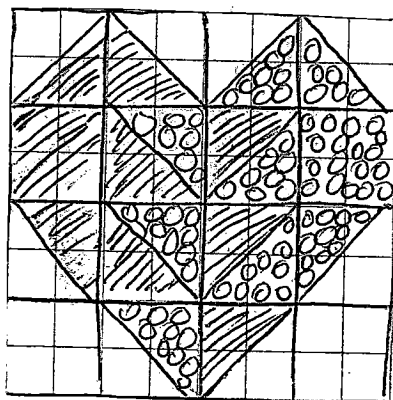

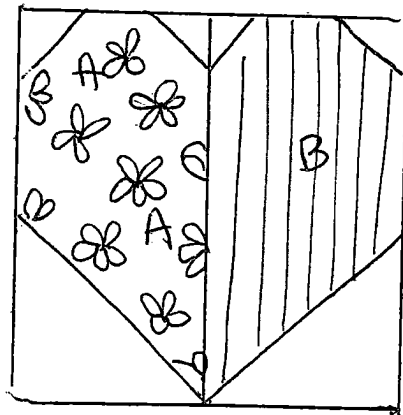
All blocks!

Arrange blocks as illustrated

Sew horizontal rows together.

Join rows.

* Pressing seams open reduces bulk. If not, iron row 1+3 in one direction 2+4 in the opposite and nest seams.

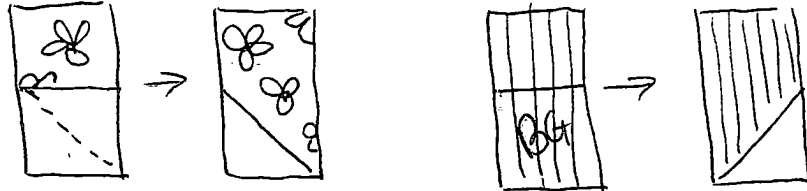

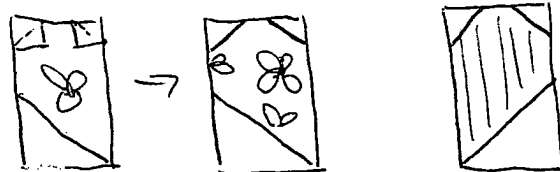

Construction

1. Add Corner squares to bottom of each rectangle, making sure they are oriented correctly



2. Then add $1\frac{1}{2}$ " corner squares to upper corners of both rectangles



3. Sew center seam.
